Before her nomination by President Barack Obama to the U.S. CSB in 2015, Dr. Kulinowski developed an illustrious career in both government and academic arenas. She provided technical guidance on science and technology policy issues for the White House and U.S. Congress as a Research Staff Member of federally funded R&D institutes such as IDA STPI. Dr. Kulinowski also served as Senior Faculty Fellow in Chemistry at Rice University, Executive Director for the Center for Biological and Environmental Nanotechnology (CBEN), and the Director of the International Council on Nanotechnology (ICON). Furthermore, Dr. Kulinowski is a Canisius College and University of Rochester alumna.
